

**A SUMMARY OF MINUTES OF THE PAROCHIAL CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING
HELD ON 27th MAY 2021 AT 7:30PM**

1. Opening Prayer

Jeremy Bamber opened the meeting with a prayer.

Felicity Leeson, Carly Taylor and Tim Telford were welcomed onto the PCC, and Carole Darling was welcomed as a new deanery synod member.

2. Apologies for Absence

There were 21 PCC members in attendance, as well as three observers. There was one apology for absence.

3. Minutes of Zoom Meetings 25th March, 13th April and 12th May 2021

The minutes of the PCC meeting on 25th March 2021 were approved. An additional meeting had been held on 13th April 2021 regarding the interregnum, and a short PCC meeting following the APCM was held on 12th May 2021. The minutes of these meetings were approved.

4. Matters Arising

A proposal to continue with and develop the internship programme, offering two internships over the next three years, was approved to go ahead when the leadership team deem appropriate.

5. Safeguarding

There were no safeguarding issues to be reported. The safeguarding statement was approved. There was discussion about the appropriate level of safeguarding training for PCC members.

6. Standing Committee Decisions

There were no standing committee decisions in this period.

7. Finance

The current finances of TRINITY were discussed. A change to the Café mandate was approved. The need for a PCC member to join the finance team was discussed. A proposal to advertise for a new treasurer for TRINITY as a voluntary position was approved.

8. TRINITY

Final checks concerning the Land Registry entry for 43 Winterbourne Lodge were completed, and the money from the sale of St. John's church hall was received, completing these two projects.

The interregnum was discussed. The churchwardens presented the allocation of duties, the status of different ministries was discussed including the reopening of the Café.

TRINITY's parish representatives reported an additional round of advertising for the new Rector, and expenses for the interview process were approved.

The constitution of the standing committee was discussed and the existing members were ratified.

9. Buildings Report

Approval for redecorating the rectory was approved. A new architect for TRINITY was approved. A health and safety investigation at St John-sub-Castro was approved. The revised health and safety policy was approved.

10. Mission Team – Including Recommendations

The PCC approved allocations for Lisa and Isaac Buyinza for their work in Uganda, Life in Abundance for their ministry in Africa, and Open Hands for their ministry in Romania, Prison Fellowship, Wycliffe Bible Translators, Feba Radio and SIM.

11. General Data Protection Regulation

There were no breaches.

12. Defining Church Activities for Insurance Liability

The PCC approved a walk and two bike rides for TRINITY Men.

13. Any Other Business

The TRINITY Anti-Racism Statement of Purpose was introduced.
